1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO BAN CORPORAL PUNISHMENT FROM CERTAIN
3 "NONREGISTERED" DAY CARE THAT RECEIVES REIMBURSEMENT
4 FROM THE STATE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Article 7 of Chapter 110 of the General Statutes is amended by
7 adding a new section to read:

8 "**§ 110-101.1. Corporal punishment banned in certain 'nonregistered' homes.**

9 (a) The use of corporal punishment as a form of discipline is prohibited in those
10 day care homes that are not required to be registered under this Article but that receive
11 State subsidies for child day care unless this care is provided to children by their
12 grandparents, aunts, uncles, step-grandparents, or great-grandparents. Care provided
13 children by their grandparents, aunts, uncles, step-grandparents, or great-grandparents is
14 not subject to this section. Religious sponsored nonregistered homes are also exempt
15 from this section."

16 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to acts of discipline
17 imposed on or after this date.
