A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION FROM SETTING
HIGHER CLASS SIZE MAXIMUMS FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION CLASSES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 115C-301(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) Alternative Maximum Class Sizes. – The State Board of Education, in its discretion, may set higher maximum class sizes and daily teaching loads for classes in ~~music, physical education, music~~ and other similar subjects, so long as the effectiveness of the instructional programs in those areas is not thereby impaired."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and applies to class sizes for all school years beginning with the 1993-94 school year.
