1 A JOINT RESOLUTION HONORING THE FOUNDERS OF THE TOWN OF
2 ABERDEEN ON ITS ONE-HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY.

3 Whereas, the Town of Aberdeen in Moore County will be celebrating 100
4 years of incorporation on March 4, 1993; and

5 Whereas, the founders of the Town of Aberdeen made great contributions to
6 the town; and

7 Whereas, the town was known as Blue's Crossing until it was renamed in
8 1887 for the seaport in Scotland; and

9 Whereas, the Town of Aberdeen has been home to many great citizens
10 including the Honorable H. Clifton Blue, former Speaker of the North Carolina House
11 of Representatives; and

12 Whereas, the Town of Aberdeen is known for its contributions to industry
13 and agriculture; and

14 Whereas, the citizens of the Town of Aberdeen have been actively preparing
15 for the town's centennial celebration;

16 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

17 Section 1. The General Assembly honors the founders of the Town of
18 Aberdeen and joins the town's citizens in celebrating the town's one-hundredth
19 anniversary.

20 Sec. 2. The Secretary of State shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution
21 to the Mayor of the Town of Aberdeen and to the Chair of the Moore County Board of
22 County Commissioners.

23 Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
