Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred thirty-nine thousand four hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$239,439) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred thirty-nine thousand four hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$239,439) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, for the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, Health Affairs, for TEACCH, the Treatment and Education of Autistic and other Communication-Handicapped Children and Adults Program, to assist with the administrative and research maintenance budget.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
