A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE TEACCH PROGRAM, WHICH  
PROVIDES EDUCATION AND TREATMENT TO CHILDREN AND ADULTS  
WITH AUTISM AND OTHER COMMUNICATION HANDICAPS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred thirty-nine  
thousand four hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$239,439) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the  
sum of two hundred thirty-nine thousand four hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$239,439) for  
the 1994-95 fiscal year, for the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, Health  
Affairs, for TEACCH, the Treatment and Education of Autistic and other  
Communication-Handicapped Children and Adults Program, to assist with the  
administrative and research maintenance budget.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
