13 14 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study issues relating to surface water and groundwater, including the following: regional management of the State's water resources; watershed protection; the effect on the State's water resources of pollution caused by package treatment plants, hog farms, pesticides, sedimentation, stormwater runoff, and land application of petroleum products; the need for a statewide groundwater program; and the State Water Supply Plan. The Commission may further study any other issues relevant to the State's water resources.

Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make its recommendations and submit an interim report to the 1993 General Assembly, Regular Session 1994, and may make a final report to the 1995 General Assembly.

Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
