February 8, 1993 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO REMOVE THE STATE AUDITOR FROM THE BOARD OF 3 TRUSTEES OF THE NORTH CAROLINA FIREMEN'S AND RESCUE SOUAD 4 WORKERS' PENSION FUND. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 58-86-5 reads as rewritten: 6 "§ 58-86-5. Creation and membership of board of trustees; compensation. 7 There is created a board to be known as the 'Board of Trustees of the North Carolina 8 Firemen's and Rescue Squad Workers' Pension Fund', hereinafter known as 'the board'. 9 The board shall consist of seven-six members: 10 The State Treasurer, who shall act as chairman. 11 (1) **(2)** The State Insurance Commissioner. 12 The State Auditor. 13 $\left(3\right)$ 14 Four members to be appointed by the Governor; one a paid fireman, one a volunteer fireman, one volunteer rescue squad 15 worker, and one representing the public at large, for terms of four 16 years each. These members may succeed themselves. 17 18 The members presently serving on the 'Board of Trustees of the Firemen's Pension Fund' shall continue to serve until the expiration of their terms. No member of the board 19 shall receive any salary, compensation or expenses other than that provided in G.S. 138-20
