A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION
PROGRAM AT NORTH CAROLINA STATE UNIVERSITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year to effect a transfer of the agricultural extension program at North Carolina State University from the College of Education and Psychology to the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences. If the Board of Governors decides to transfer the program, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) shall be used for capital costs of the program and the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) shall be used for operating expenses of the program. If the Board of Governors decides not to transfer the program, these funds shall revert to the General Fund on June 30, 1994.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
