G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten: Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of 7 "(a) charge one registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 8 100% disabled veteran, a recipient of the Purple Heart award, and an ex-prisoner of war. 9 All other special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration 10 fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount: 11 12 Special Plate Additional Fee Amount **Historical Attraction** 13 \$30.00 14 Collegiate Insignia \$25.00 Personalized 15 \$20.00 All other Special Plates \$10.00 16 Active Member of the National Guard 17 None".
