A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES SHALL PROVIDE ONE PURPLE HEART RECIPIENT REGISTRATION PLATE FREE OF CHARGE TO A QUALIFIED APPLICANT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Fees. - Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled veteran, a recipient of the Purple Heart award, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

Historical Attraction	\$30.00
Collegiate Insignia	\$25.00
Personalized	\$20.00
All other Special Plates	\$10.00
Active Member of the National Guard	None".

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993.
