Section 1. Rule 67 of the Permanent Rules of the Senate for the Regular Sessions of the 1993 General Assembly, as contained in Simple Senate Resolution 823 (adopted April 19, 1993), reads as rewritten:

"RULE 67. Admission to the floor of the Senate.—No person except members of the Senate, members of the House of Representatives, staff of the General Assembly; staff of the Lieutenant Governor; Judges of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, and Superior Courts; the Governor and members of the Council of State; former members of

- 13 the General Assembly; and persons particularly invited and extended the privileges of
- the floor by the Presiding Officer shall be admitted to the floor of the Senate during its
- 15 session. Notwithstanding any other provision of these rules, no registered lobbyist shall
- 16 be admitted to the floor of the Senate or Senate Chamber while the Senate is in session.
- When the Senate is not in daily session, the President Pro Tempore shall determine the
- 18 privileges of the floor."
 - Sec. 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
