1 A SENATE RESOLUTION AMENDING THE PERMANENT RULES OF THE
2 SENATE FOR THE REGULAR SESSIONS OF THE 1993 GENERAL
3 ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA RELATING TO RECALL OF BILL FROM
4 COMMITTEE AND TO ADMISSION TO THE FLOOR OF THE SENATE.

5 Be it resolved by the Senate:

6 Section 1. The Permanent Rules of the Senate for the Regular Sessions of the
7 1993 General Assembly, as contained in Simple Senate Resolution 823 (adopted April
8 19, 1993), are modified in the following ways:

9 (a) Rule 47(b) reads as rewritten:

10 "(b) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, the chairman of a committee to
11 which a bill or other matter is assigned may, with the consent of two-thirds of the
12 membership of the Senate present and voting, recall the measure to be referred to
13 another ~~committee.~~ committee or the floor."

14 (b) A new rule is added to read:

15 "RULE 67A. Restricted admission to the floor of the Senate prior to the daily
16 session.—No person, except members of the Senate; members of the House of
17 Representatives; staff of the General Assembly; the staff of the Lieutenant Governor;
18 Judges of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, and Superior Courts; the Governor and
19 members of the Council of State; former members of the General Assembly; and
20 persons particularly invited and extended the privileges of the floor by the Presiding
21 Officer, shall be admitted to or remain on the floor of the Senate within 15 minutes prior
22 to the Senate's scheduled daily session. Notwithstanding any other provision of this
23 rule, no registered lobbyist shall be admitted to or remain on the floor of the Senate

1 within 15 minutes prior to the Senate's scheduled daily session. This rule is repealed
2 effective June 10, 1993."

3 Sec. 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
