A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT CONCERNING USER FEES BY THE TOWN OF GARNER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Town of Garner may enact ordinances which provide for the collection of reasonable fees for the administration of lawful powers heretofore granted to municipalities by public law in the areas of police powers and land-use regulations, including, but not limited to, reasonable water/sewer taps and acreage fees, meter and backflow prevention device installation fees, and fees for the filing of zoning applications, the publishing of legal notice provided by the town to the public, applications for variances, parks and recreation user fees, senior citizen user fees, specialized solid waste pickup, and other applications and procedures for which the Town incurs expenses as a result of matters initiated by individuals, firms, and corporations.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
