A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES'
COMMUNITY-BASED ALTERNATIVE SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Youth Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, for the expansion of community-based services. Twenty-five percent (25%) of these funds shall be allocated equally among all 100 counties and seventy-five percent (75%) shall be allocated to the counties on a per capita basis.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
