

1 (d) If a person has completed an application to register under this section, but
2 prior to the time the person has attained the age of eligibility to be registered to vote,
3 that person obtains a:

4 (1) Duplicate license under G.S. 20-7.1; or

5 (2) Reissued special identification card under G.S. 20-37.9,

6 on account of change of address, that change of address shall be considered as updating
7 the voter's application to register under this section. If the change of address is to a
8 different county, then the first county shall not send a registration notice, and the second
9 county shall treat the change of address notice as an application to register under this
10 section.

11 (e) The State Board of Elections is authorized to promulgate rules necessary to
12 implement the provisions of this section."
