A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR TO CONDUCT INFORMATIONAL INSPECTIONS OF SHELTERS FOR 3 HOMELESS PERSONS. 4 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. (a) As used in this act, "shelter for homeless persons" means a 6 supervised publicly or privately operated facility designed to provide temporary 7 sleeping accommodations without charge for persons who do not have and cannot 8 9 afford sleeping accommodations. This act shall not apply to: 10 (b) A shelter that provides services to six or fewer persons. 11 (1)An emergency shelter set up in response to and immediately following 12 (2)13 a natural disaster. A shelter operated primarily to provide services to victims of domestic 14 (3) violence, as defined in G.S. 50B-1. 15 Sec. 2. (a) The Department of Labor shall conduct informational inspections 16 of homeless shelters to identify potential health and safety concerns and shall: 17 Compile information regarding the condition and operation of 18 (1)homeless shelters to determine the extent to which the shelters are 19 20 providing minimally acceptable accommodations in terms of health 21 and safety.

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1	(2)	Provide informational reports and recommendations regarding health
2		and safety conditions of each homeless shelter to the owner and
3		operator of the shelter and to the county or district health department
4		following each inspection.
5	(3)	Provide information and recommendations regarding health and safety
6		conditions to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural
7		Resources and the Commission for Health Services to assist the
8		Commission in rule making pursuant to G.S. 130A-235.1.
9	(b) Report	s of inspections of homeless shelters are public documents.
10	Sec. 3.	The Department of Labor, the Department of Environment, Health,
11	and Natural Resources, and the Commission for Health Services shall jointly report to	
12	the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations as to their findings and	
13	recommendations regarding health and safety conditions in homeless shelters. The	
14	report shall include recommendations on the resources necessary to adequately inspect	
15	homeless shelters and on how best to enforce rules relating to health and safety	
16	conditions in homeless shelters without causing severe economic hardship to the	
17	operation of the homeless shelters. An initial report shall be made by 31 March 1995	
18	and a final report	shall be made by 31 December 1995.
19	Sec. 4.	This act shall not be construed to obligate the General Assembly to
20	appropriate funds	s to implement the provisions of this act. The Department of Labor, the
21	Department of E	nvironment, Health, and Natural Resources, and the Commission for
22	Health Services shall implement the provisions of this act from funds otherwise	
23	appropriated or available to each agency.	

24 Sec. 5. This act becomes effective 1 September 1994 and expires 31 25 December 1995.
