**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE THE PERSONAL NEEDS  
ALLOWANCE FOR CERTAIN DOMICILIARY CARE RESIDENTS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Social Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of two million seven hundred seventy-seven thousand four hundred dollars (\$2,777,400) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of two million nine hundred seventeen thousand fifty dollars (\$2,917,050) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, to increase the personal needs allowance for domiciliary care residents receiving State-County Special Assistance for Adults from twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) a month to fifty dollars (\$50.00) a month.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
