A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CENTER FOR EMPLOYMENT TRAINING.

Whereas, the northwest piedmont region of the State is one of 10 areas selected nationally to develop a Center for Employment Training for programs that combine job skills training with remedial education in mathematics and English language; and

Whereas, the Northwest Piedmont Job Training Consortium, one of 26 State JTPA service delivery areas, is sponsoring the Center for Employment Training and is contributing one hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$160,000) of federal JPTA funds to develop the program; and

Whereas, additional funds are needed from the State to develop and implement the Center and its programs; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred eighteen thousand dollars (\$318,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be allocated to the Center for Employment Training as follows:

- (1) Of the funds appropriated for the 1993-94 fiscal year, \$182,000 shall be nonrecurring grant funds;
- (2) Funds appropriated in this section are contingent upon matching funds of \$160,000 in each fiscal year. If the amount of non-State revenues received by the Northwest Piedmont Job Training Consortium for the Center for Employment Training is greater than \$160,000 in each

	fiscal year, then the funds appropriated in this section for the Center
2	shall be reduced by the amount of non-State revenues exceeding
3	\$160,000 received in each fiscal year.
1	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
