- AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT AUTOMATED PHONE SYSTEMS OPERATED BY
 STATE GOVERNMENT AGENCIES REDUCE THE NUMBER OF MENUS
- 4 THAT CALLERS MUST GO THROUGH TO CONNECT TO A PERSON, AND
- 5 ALLOW ACCESS TO SOME PERSON AT ANY TIME.
- 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. State agency telephone systems routing calls to multiple 8 extensions shall be reprogrammed by January 1, 1994, to minimize the number of 9 menus that a caller must go through to reach the desired extension, and to allow the 10 caller on the first menu to reach an attendant or operator.

11 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
