## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CAROLINA THEATRE PROJECT3 IN DURHAM.

4 Whereas, the Carolina Theatre in Durham is one of the few remaining historic 5 structures in downtown Durham, having been built in 1926; and

6 Whereas, the Carolina Theatre is the keystone to the economic revitalization 7 of downtown Durham, providing the link between the Durham Civic Center and the 8 Durham Arts Council; and

9 Whereas, the renovated and expanded Carolina Theatre promises to bring 10 people from throughout the central North Carolina region to downtown Durham every 11 day and every evening of the year; and

Whereas, the Carolina Theatre will be an educational resource for the children of Durham, teaching them about Durham's history, architecture, arts, and culture; and

15 Whereas, the Carolina Theatre will be the gathering place for Durham's 16 citizens, celebrating the city's rich cultural diversity; Now, therefore,

17 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

18 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Carolina 19 Theatre Project the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1993-20 94 fiscal year for completion of construction and furnishing of the Carolina Theatre, 21 provided these funds are matched on the basis of two dollars (\$2.00) of non-State funds 22 for every one dollar (\$1.00) of State funds.

23 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
