A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO REPLACE THE TRESTLE OVER THE
NEWPORT RIVER ON THE BEAUFORT AND MOREHEAD RAILROAD.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina Ports Railway Commission the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year to replace the wooden trestle over the Newport River on the Beaufort and Morehead Railroad with a modern concrete trestle.

Sec. 2. The North Carolina Ports Railway Commission shall use the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act and additional funds available to the Commission, including the proceeds of property it may dispose of for purposes of this act, to replace the trestle.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
