1 A SENATE RESOLUTION PETITIONING THE DEFENSE BASE CLOSURE AND 2 REALIGNMENT COMMISSION TO RETAIN THE CHERRY POINT NAVAL 3 AVIATION DEPOT.

Whereas, the Cherry Point Naval Aviation Depot received the highest score on the military value matrix of the Department of Defense; and

Whereas, the Cherry Point Naval Aviation Depot is the only two-time winner of the Federal Quality Institute's Quality Improvement Prototype Award; and

Whereas, the Cherry Point Naval Aviation Depot has the greatest accumulation of operating revenue of any of the Naval Aviation Depots in the nation; and

Whereas, the Cherry Point Naval Aviation Depot employs 3,200 civilians in Eastern North Carolina and is the largest single employer in Eastern North Carolina; and

Whereas, the loss of this many jobs in Eastern North Carolina would represent a larger percentage job loss than in at least four of the other Naval Aviation Depot locations;
