1 A SENATE RESOLUTION PETITIONING THE DEFENSE BASE CLOSURE AND  
2 REALIGNMENT COMMISSION TO RETAIN THE CHERRY POINT NAVAL  
3 AVIATION DEPOT.

4       Whereas, the Cherry Point Naval Aviation Depot received the highest score  
5 on the military value matrix of the Department of Defense; and

6       Whereas, the Cherry Point Naval Aviation Depot is the only two-time winner  
7 of the Federal Quality Institute's Quality Improvement Prototype Award; and

8       Whereas, the Cherry Point Naval Aviation Depot has the greatest  
9 accumulation of operating revenue of any of the Naval Aviation Depots in the nation;  
10 and

11       Whereas, the Cherry Point Naval Aviation Depot employs 3,200 civilians in  
12 Eastern North Carolina and is the largest single employer in Eastern North Carolina;  
13 and

14       Whereas, the loss of this many jobs in Eastern North Carolina would  
15 represent a larger percentage job loss than in at least four of the other Naval Aviation  
16 Depot locations;

17 Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Senate:

18       Section 1. The North Carolina Senate petitions the Defense Base Closure and  
19 Realignment Commission to retain the Cherry Point Naval Aviation Depot, the most  
20 cost-efficient and productive Naval Aviation Depot in the Department of Defense.

21       Sec. 2. The Principal Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution to  
22 the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Commission.

23       Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
