A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A TOXICOLOGY BUILDING AT NORTH CAROLINA STATE UNIVERSITY.

Whereas, the effects of chemicals on human health and the environment, and the uses of chemicals in industry, agriculture, and everyday life, is a matter of public concern for the people of this State; and

Whereas, the North Carolina State University Department of Toxicology has played a significant role in these matters of public concern; and

Whereas, the current facilities being used by the Department of Toxicology include six different locations and are no longer adequate; and

Whereas, the need for a new facility to house the North Carolina State University Department of Toxicology is critical; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of twelve million nine hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$12,960,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year for the construction of a building to house the Department of Toxicology at North Carolina State University.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
