The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 130A-337(c) reads as rewritten:

Upon determination that an existing wastewater system that is to be '(c) physically connected to a manufactured home and that serves only that manufactured home has a valid operation permit or a valid certificate of completion and is operating properly in a manufactured home park, the local health department shall issue authorization in writing for a manufactured home to be connected to the existing system and to be occupied. Notwithstanding G.S. 130A-336, an improvement permit is not required for the connection of a manufactured home to an existing system with a valid operation permit or a valid certificate of completion in a manufactured home park."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
