A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
STUDY ALTERNATIVE REVENUE SOURCES FOR STATE GOVERNMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study alternative revenue sources for State government. It may consider the revenue sources that already exist, those that are proposed, and the impact of fees levied by State agencies.

Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make a report and recommendations to the 1993 General Assembly, Regular Session 1994, and a final report to the 1995 General Assembly.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Research Commission the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year to fund the study.

Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
