A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
2 STUDY THE IMPACT OF THE NORTH AMERICAN FREE TRADE
3 AGREEMENT ON NORTH CAROLINA.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the impact of
7 the North American Free Trade Agreement on North Carolina and how the State and
8 industries can maximize their participation in and the benefits from N.A.F.T.A.

9 Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make a report and
10 recommendations to the 1993 General Assembly, Regular Session 1994, and a final
11 report to the 1995 General Assembly.

12 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative
13 Research Commission the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1993-94
14 fiscal year to fund the study.

15 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
