**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND  
NATURAL RESOURCES TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF DEVELOPING  
THE MOUNTAIN ISLAND LAKE AREA AS A REGIONAL STATE PARK.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources shall review the needs of the State Parks System as described in the Plan in accordance with G.S. 113-44.14(b) and determine the feasibility and cost of developing the Mountain Island Lake area in Gaston, Lincoln, and Mecklenburg Counties as a regional State Park.

Sec. 2. The Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources shall report the results of this study to the 1993 General Assembly (Regular Session 1994) no later than June 1, 1994.

Sec. 3. The Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources shall perform this study with funds within its budget for the 1993-94 fiscal year.

Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
