1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH  
2 CAROLINA SCHOOL OF MEDICINE'S STATEWIDE INFECTION CONTROL  
3 PROGRAM.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
7 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars  
8 (\$75,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, for the Statewide Infection Control Program at the  
9 School of Medicine of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. The Statewide  
10 Infection Control Program focuses on the development of infection control programs in  
11 community hospitals and other health care facilities in North Carolina by providing  
12 infection control consultation and educational programs for the training of infection  
13 control practitioners.

14 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
