A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR TEACCH'S RESEARCH AND SERVICES FOR PEOPLE WITH AUTISM AND THEIR FAMILIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina, the sum of one million one hundred fifty-one thousand four hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$1,151,439) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, for Division TEACCH, of the School of Medicine at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, for TEACCH's research and services for people with autism and their families.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
