A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR PESTICIDE PROGRAM EXPANSION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture the sum of one million six thousand two hundred thirty-one dollars (\$1,006,231) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for establishment and administration of pesticide specific management plans.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of one hundred sixty-eight thousand three hundred thirteen dollars (\$168,313) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for continuation of mapping, monitoring, and impact assessment capabilities developed under the Interagency Pesticides and Groundwater Study to support NCDA pesticide management plans.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
