A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO THE
MEDICAL SCHOOL AT EAST CAROLINA UNIVERSITY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million three hundred thousand dollars (\$2,300,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for construction of a medical waste incinerator at East Carolina University School of Medicine.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for design funds for the Life Sciences Building at East Carolina University School of Medicine.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million five hundred seventy-four thousand dollars (\$1,574,000) for construction of a linear accelerator at East Carolina School of Medicine.

Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million three hundred sixteen thousand seven hundred dollars (\$1,316,700) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for clinic renovations at East Carolina University School of Medicine.

Sec. 5. The appropriations made in Sections 1 through 4 of this act shall be made from Medicare reimbursements being held in special fund account on deposit with the State Treasurer created pursuant to Section 87(a)(3) of Chapter 321 of the 1993 Session Laws.

1 Sec. 6. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
