A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT  
PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO CLARIFY POLICY CONCERNING  
CORRECTION ENTERPRISES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Department of Administration, Purchase and Contracts  
Division, in consultation with the Department of Correction, shall develop policy  
concerning the manufacture of goods and the provision of services by Correction  
Enterprises. The policy shall be for distribution to all State agencies and departments  
and shall:

- (1) Address the appropriate levels of production and services by  
Correction Enterprises;
- (2) Provide guidelines for purchase by State agencies from Correction  
Enterprises whenever Correction Enterprises offers lower prices for  
quality products than other potential vendors; and
- (3) Identify the potential benefits to prisoner rehabilitation as a result of  
the Correction Enterprises program.

The Department of Administration shall submit the policy for approval by the  
General Assembly by March 15, 1994.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
