A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO RESTORE PREVIOUS

APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE KELLOGG ESTATE COMMUNITY CENTER AT

THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT ASHEVILLE.

Whereas, the Kellogg Estate Community Center is in need of restoration and expansion; and

Whereas, in previous fiscal years, the center received appropriations from the State but lost the funds due to other budget needs; and

Whereas, the land upon which the center is located is valued at \$1,000,000, but is not being taken advantage of because of the inadequacy of the center's facilities; and

Whereas, restoration and expansion of the center would serve as a valuable resource by expanding educational opportunities from the University of North Carolina at Asheville into Henderson and Transylvania Counties and by promoting rural economic development; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$375,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the University of North Carolina at Asheville to restore and expand the Kellogg Estate Community Center.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
