1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGE CAPITAL
3 PROJECTS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
6 Community Colleges the sum of twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000) for the 1994-
7 95 fiscal year for Community College capital projects. These funds shall be allocated as
8 follows:

8 Projected allocations set forth above may be adjusted to reflect the
9 availability of other funds. The Board of Trustees of an individual community college
10 may change the projects or allocations for that college, but not for a satellite campus,
11 within the total amount of funds allocated for that college; the Board of Trustees may
12 not, however, change, reduce, or eliminate a project or an allocation at a satellite
13 campus of the community college.

14 The Director of the Budget is empowered, when the Director of the Budget
15 determines it is in the best interest of the State and the North Carolina Community
16 College System to do so, and if the cost of a particular project is less than the projected
17 allocation, to use the excess funds to increase the size of that project or increase the size
18 of any other project itemized in this section, or to increase the amount allocated to a
19 particular community college within the aggregate amount of funds available under this
20 section. The Director of the Budget may consult with the Advisory Budget Commission
21 and the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations before making these
22 changes. In addition, the particular capital improvements and the amount of the
23 projected allocation therefor set forth above may be changed from time to time as the
24 General Assembly may decide.

25 The matching requirements of G.S. 115D-31(a)(1) apply to the allocations
26 made to community colleges in this section.

27 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
