AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSOLIDATING STATE AND FEDERAL SURPLUS PROPERTY FUNCTIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Department of Administration shall study the feasibility of consolidating the property units of the State Surplus Property Section and the Federal Surplus Property Section at the federal facility site. In the course of the study the Department shall consider enhanced service the consolidation would provide to customers, the funds that the State would realize from the sale of the State facility, annual savings that would result from decreased staffing required by a consolidated facility, and the feasibility and cost of constructing sufficient additional space at the federal facility to house a consolidated facility.

The Department shall report to the General Assembly on the results of this study before March 15, 1994.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
