A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE COMPLETION OF A NEW ARTS
CENTER/CIVIC CENTER IN LENOIR COUNTY.**

Whereas, Lenoir County is to be the future location of the Global TransPark;
and

Whereas, the Community Council for the Arts provides the citizens of the
City of Kinston, Lenoir County, and Eastern North Carolina with access to social,
cultural, and educational benefits; and

Whereas, great progress has been made in the renovation of a vacant building
known as the Midyette Hardware Store located in downtown Kinston into a model Arts
Center/Civic Center; and

Whereas, funds are needed to pay for the completion of the new Arts
Center/Civic Center; Now, therefore,
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of
Kinston the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year
to meet obligations toward the completion of a new Arts Center/Civic Center in the
Midyette Hardware Store Building, provided these funds are matched on the basis of
one dollar (\$1.00) of non-State funds for every one dollar (\$1.00) of State funds.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
