4	Whereas, Lenoir County is to be the future location of the Global TransPark;

6	Whereas, the Community Council for the Arts provides the citizens of the
7	City of Kinston, Lenoir County, and Eastern North Carolina with access to social,
8	cultural, and educational benefits; and
9	Whereas, great progress has been made in the renovation of a vacant building
10	known as the Midyette Hardware Store located in downtown Kinston into a model Arts
11	Center/Civic Center; and
12	Whereas, funds are needed to pay for the completion of the new Arts
13	Center/Civic Center; Now, therefore,
14	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
15	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the City of Kinston the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to meet obligations toward the completion of a new Arts Center/Civic Center in the Midyette Hardware Store Building, provided these funds are matched on the basis of one dollar (\$1.00) of non-State funds for every one dollar (\$1.00) of State funds.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
