A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR MULTIDISCIPLINARY TRAINING
FOR CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT INVESTIGATIONS, AS
RECOMMENDED BY THE CHILD FATALITY TASK FORCE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Criminal Information Division, Department of Justice, the sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for multidisciplinary training for the investigations of child abuse and neglect. These funds shall provide for a trainer position and essential training equipment and materials. The training shall be provided statewide for law enforcement officers, county department of social services workers, court officials, child advocates, and public health, mental health, and other professionals who serve children and families.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
