AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT

PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE DIRECTING THE GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION TO DEVELOP A CENTRAL AUTOMATED INVENTORY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR THE STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Secretary of Administration shall, after consultation with the State Controller, develop a central automated inventory management system to facilitate agency and department access to information on surplus property. The system shall combine State and federal surplus inventory information and shall be accessible from all State agencies and local governments. The system shall provide information on the available surplus property inventory, the age and fair market value of the inventory, and the physical condition of the items and the dates they were reported as surplus.

The Secretary of Administration shall report to the General Assembly prior to March 15, 1994, on the system he develops pursuant to this section.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
