A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND

NATURAL RESOURCES TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF DEVELOPING

THE MOUNTAIN ISLAND LAKE AREA AS A REGIONAL STATE PARK.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources shall review the needs of the State Parks System as described in the Plan in accordance with G.S. 113-44.14(b) and determine the feasibility and cost of developing the Mountain Island Lake Area in Gaston, Lincoln, and Mecklenburg Counties as a regional State Park.

- Sec. 2. The Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources shall report the results of this study to the 1995 General Assembly.
- Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to study the feasibility of developing the Mountain Island Lake Area as a regional State Park.
 - Sec. 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
