A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND
NATURAL RESOURCES TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF DEVELOPING
THE MOUNTAIN ISLAND LAKE AREA AS A REGIONAL STATE PARK.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources shall review the needs of the State Parks System as described in the Plan in accordance with G.S. 113-44.14(b) and determine the feasibility and cost of developing the Mountain Island Lake Area in Gaston, Lincoln, and Mecklenburg Counties as a regional State Park.

Sec. 2. The Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources shall report the results of this study to the 1995 General Assembly.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to study the feasibility of developing the Mountain Island Lake Area as a regional State Park.

Sec. 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
