S 1 SENATE BILL 1481 Short Title: Old Salem Museum Funds. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Kaplan and Ward. Referred to: Appropriations. May 25, 1994 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO AND SUPPORT OF EXHIBIT AT THE OLD SALEM MUSEUM. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Old Salem, Inc., the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be used as follows: \$250,000 in capital funds to construct an addition to the Old Salem (1) Museum. These funds shall be matched with local funds in the amount of one dollar of local funds for every two dollars of State funds; and \$250,000 to support the development of the exhibit pertaining to the (2) Czech Republic. Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
