1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL EXPENDITURES FOR VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION PROGRAMS THAT PROVIDE ADULT DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITY PROGRAMS (ADAP) AND VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, to be distributed for capital expenditures among 127 vocational rehabilitation programs that provide Adult Developmental Activity Programs (ADAP) and vocational rehabilitation programs, in order to effect the federal mandate of the Rehabilitation Act, as amended in 1992, to provide services to the most significantly disabled and to provide expanded services that allow for consumer choice as described in "A Comprehensive Plan for Services and Supports for Persons with Developmental Disabilities".

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
