A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE SALARIES OF CERTAIN JUDICIAL BRANCH OFFICERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 56 of Chapter 321 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 56. (a) The annual salaries, payable monthly, for specified judicial branch officials for fiscal year 1993-94 and fiscal year 1994-95 are:

8 The district attorney or public defender of a judicial district, with the approval of the  
 9 Administrative Officer of the Courts, shall set the salaries of assistant district attorneys  
 10 or assistant public defenders, respectively, in that district such that the average salaries  
 11 of assistant district attorneys or assistant public defenders in that district do not exceed  
 12 forty-six thousand seven hundred thirty-eight dollars (\$46,738), and the minimum salary  
 13 of any assistant district attorney or assistant public defender is at least twenty-three  
 14 thousand eight hundred sixty-two dollars (\$23,862) effective July 1, 1993.

36 (b) The salaries in effect for fiscal year 1992-93 for permanent, full-time  
 37 employees of the Judicial Department, except for those whose salaries are itemized in  
 38 this act, shall be increased by two percent (2%), commencing July 1, 1993.

39 (c) The salaries in effect for fiscal year 1992-93 for all permanent, part-time  
 40 employees of the Judicial Department shall be increased on and after July 1, 1993, by  
 41 pro rata amounts of the two percent (2%)."

42 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
