2	AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT
3	PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE THAT THE DIVISION OF MOTOR
4	VEHICLES ENHANCE ITS AUTOMATED VEHICLE REGISTRATION
5	SYSTEM AND ENCOURAGE GREATER USE OF MAIL-IN REGISTRATIONS
6	AND OTHER INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS TO IMPROVE EFFICIENCY.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall submit a report to the
9	General Assembly, not later than November 1, 1993, containing proposals for
10	enhancing the efficiency of the motor vehicle registration process. The report shall
11	contain consideration of:
12	(1) Encouraging vehicle owners to mail in their vehicle registration
13	materials, thereby reducing the need for 126 registration offices.
14	(2) Purchasing a computer system that will accommodate direct
15	transmission of registration information by contractors and branch
16	offices to a central system at least on a daily basis.
17	(3) Accommodating possible future applications such as direct customer
18	telephone input through automated teller machines and using credit
19	cards.
20	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
