A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT
PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE THAT THE DIVISION OF MOTOR
VEHICLES ENHANCE ITS AUTOMATED VEHICLE REGISTRATION
SYSTEM AND ENCOURAGE GREATER USE OF MAIL-IN REGISTRATIONS
AND OTHER INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS TO IMPROVE EFFICIENCY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall submit a report to the
General Assembly, not later than November 1, 1993, containing proposals for
enhancing the efficiency of the motor vehicle registration process. The report shall
contain consideration of:

- (1) Encouraging vehicle owners to mail in their vehicle registration materials, thereby reducing the need for 126 registration offices.
- (2) Purchasing a computer system that will accommodate direct transmission of registration information by contractors and branch offices to a central system at least on a daily basis.
- (3) Accommodating possible future applications such as direct customer telephone input through automated teller machines and using credit cards.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
