February 17, 1993 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE **TRANSITION** TO INAPPROPRIATELY PLACED RESIDENTS OF INTERMEDIATE CARE FACILITIES FOR THE MENTALLY RETARDED TO HOME- AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The General Assembly finds that North Carolina continues to admit a significant number of individuals to State-operated intermediate care facilities for the mentally retarded (ICFs/MR), while most other states are moving to deinstitutionalize the mentally retarded and that there are approximately 170 individuals inappropriately placed in ICFs/MR settings. Sec. 2. Effective July 1, 1995, the Department of Human Resources shall ensure that the individuals inappropriately placed in ICFs/MR are transitioned to homeand community-based settings, where they will receive services in a more appropriate setting. The process of transition shall include: Ensuring that stringent criteria will be applied so that the excess (1) capacity in ICFs/MR created by the transition is not refilled

inappropriately again; and

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1	(2) Consideration of a capital reimbursement system to ensure that capital
2	costs, which could be reallocated among remaining residents, are not
3	reimbursed.
4	Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
