The General Assembly finds that the Certificate of Need process remains justified for long-term care beds but that the Medicaid reimbursement system 8 for these beds should be adjusted to promote savings. 9 Effective July 1, 1993, the Division of Medical Assistance, 10 Department of Human Resources shall make those changes in the Medicaid 11 reimbursement system for long-term care facilities that will promote savings. 12 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993. 13
