Referred to: Government Performance Audit February 18, 1993 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT PERFORMANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE TO DIRECT THE GOVERNOR TO 3 4 CONDUCT ORGANIZATIONAL AND STAFFING ANALYSES OF STATE AGENCIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The Governor shall conduct organizational and staffing analyses of State agencies. The analyses shall use the following guidelines: Eliminate one-on-one reporting relationships at middle management 9 and supervisory levels. 10 Achieve spans of control of three to six, with a span of control of three (2) applying to highly technical, policy-sensitive, or nonrepetitive 12 functions. 13 Consolidate units with small numbers of staff into larger, more 14 (3) 15 efficient units.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
